

2010 GNFA SHAVINGS POLICY

For NWGHA

The Fairground has also advised us of a new requirement involving shavings. This has been imposed by the Fairground Board due to some past experiences of horse injuries and/or cost.

The fee for the stalls will be \$60.00. This covers the same stall fee of \$50 we paid last year with an additional \$10.00 to cover two bags of shavings at \$5.00 each. Additional bags of shavings will be \$7.00.

The Fairgrounds Administration has asked us to make our people aware of some rules. Should you choose to bring your own shavings - you need to know the following : Also, if you bring your own and they find they do not meet these specifications - you will be required to remove all your shavings from the stall and the premises. If you refuse, you will be escorted from the fairground property.

Shavings Specifications and Standards for the Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter

1. All shavings that are used in the horse barn must meet the following specifications and standards.
2. Only bagged shavings allowed:
 - * Shavings must be compressed and in plastic bags.
 - * Plastic bags must be heat sealed, no external closures of bags allowed, such as staples, string, glue, wire, etc.
3. Only pure pine flake shavings allowed, no other treatment allowed.
4. All bagged shavings must be heat dried, (kiln process)
5. No lumber mill waste or by-products of any type.
6. All bags must have company name, address, and phone number printed on the bag.
7. All bags must have compressed volume and expanded volume printed on the bag.
